### 1. Course purpose and objectives:

The purpose of the discipline “International trade” is to provide knowledge of the basic concepts of international trade, patterns and trends that are emerging in world markets and the features of their manifestation when entering them by various subjects of the world economy.

The objectives of the discipline are:

- acquaint the audience with the types and main trends of international trade;
- provide knowledge in the field of international trade regulation and development of foreign trade policies of countries;
- develop skills to analyze the dynamics and structure of international trade in goods and services and identify development trends.

### 2. Requirements for the results of mastering the course:

As a result of mastering the competence **PC-3** students must:

1. **Know:** technical means of customs control, used in the field of international trade.
2. **Be able to:** determine the value of equipment and devices for customs control in order to develop international trade.
3. **Possess:** skills to assess the effectiveness of the use of technical means of customs control for the development of international trade.

**PC-14** – possession of skills to identify counterfeit and counterfeit goods.

As a result of mastering the competence **PC-14** students must:

1. **Know:** the commodity structure of international trade, types of counterfeit and counterfeit goods.
2. **Be able to:** determine the share of counterfeit and counterfeit goods in international trade.
3. **Possess:** skills to assess the impact of international trade in counterfeit and counterfeit goods on the state of the country's economy.
