Аннотация:

The article deals with historiography on the socio-economic development of the Black sea province during the First world war. The attention is paid to the publications that were published during the First world war and up to the present time.

The scientific researches of russian and foreign authors were used as materials in historiographical work. The methodological basis of the research is based on the principles of historicism, scientific objectivity and systematicity, which are traditional for russian historiography. For the construction of theoretical conclusions related to the processing of results based on historiographic data, a set of private analytical methods of study, including analysis and synthesis of results, abstraction, and the methodology of assumption, was used. As a result of application of analytical techniques it was succeeded to systematize the received information and to use it more effectively for theoretical constructions.

In conclusion, the authors state that there are still significant gaps on the territory of the Black Sea province in the historiography of the history of the First world war, and this topic has not been the subject of a comprehensive study. So far, the issues of hospital bases have not reflected on the territory of the Black sea province, and administrative measures aimed at combating alcoholism during the war, as well as the activities of charitable societies, have not been sufficiently studied.
